

## APPENDIX – RIDDEN TEST

### RIDDEN TEST TRIBUNALS FOR QUALIFIED BREEDING STOCK 2009

#### RIDDEN TEST

- One 20m circle at trot on each rein.
- Lengthened strides at the trot for at least 20 metres.
- One canter circle on each rein, striking off from working trot.
- A minimum of 20 metres in medium walk and a minimum of 20 metres lengthening the stride in walk, lengthening the neck of the horse, as well as the top line.
- This test must be performed in a simple snaffle or a double bridle in the case of horses over six years old, whip and spurs are optional, rising trot is permitted.
- The maximum duration will be four minutes.
- The presentation of the horse and rider clothing shall comply with the current FEI regulations.
- The judge of the test may ask the rider to perform any exercise deemed relevant for the correct evaluation of the horse.
